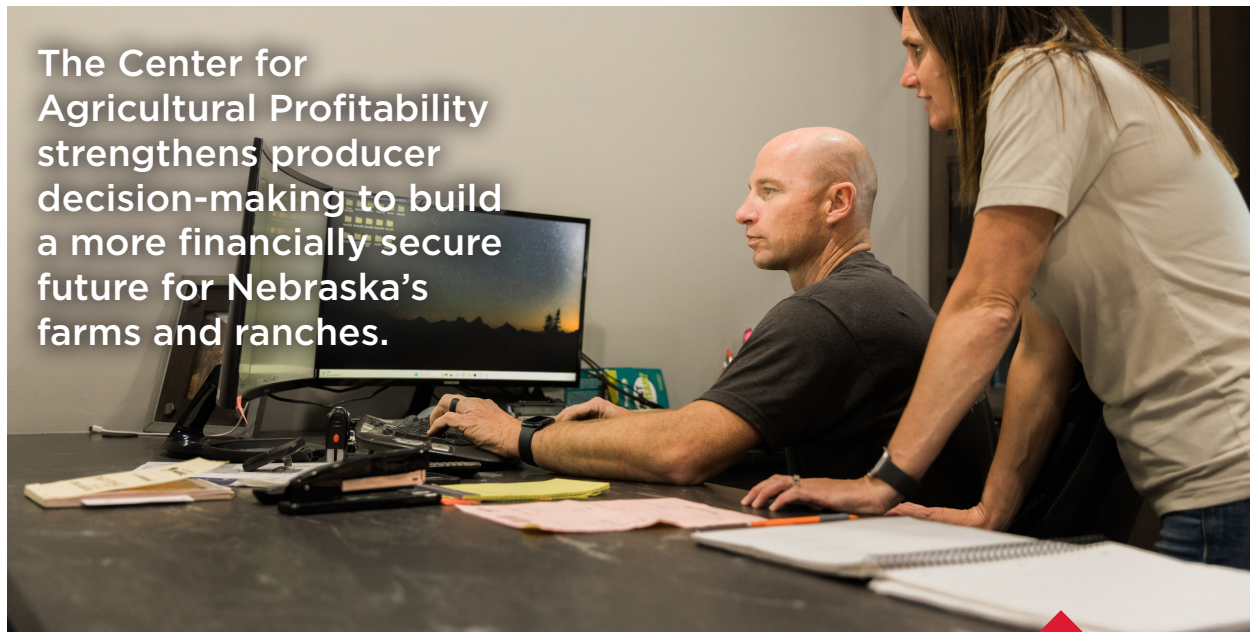


Agricultural Profitability Impact At-A-Glance

The Center for Agricultural Profitability strengthens producer decision-making to build a more financially secure future for Nebraska's farms and ranches.



The Agricultural Budget Calculator program (ABC) empowers producers to better understand their business using UNL crop budgets and other features. Users gain confidence in decision-making by modifying budgets with their own costs to calculate cost of production and other insights. Reginald Preston, of Lyman, spoke of the program's utility: "Please count me in as a producer who relies on ABC for annual planning. If I had to replicate in Excel what you've done, it would take three times as long, be half as good, and wouldn't give me the easy-to-read output to communicate with my stakeholders."

Strengthen Nebraska Agriculture & Food Systems By connecting with Nebraska Extension, Nebraska producers gain a realistic understanding of their actual cost of production by analyzing each enterprise in their operation in order to make better-informed economic decisions. That knowledge is critical in terms of understanding the impact of marketing, risk management, crop and livestock insurance, land prices and federal farm programs—even navigating the transition of an operation to the next generation. Nebraska Extension has a positive financial impact on millions of acres of farm and ranch land, helping ensure the sustainability of Nebraska agriculture by making it more profitable.
