287 North Platte High School juniors are more confident about their career choices after exploring post secondary options through the hands on Connecting the Dots simulations. Utilizing Nebraska career cluster framework, the 6-hour interactive career simulation is designed to connect student interests to area career experts as well as how to “connect the dots” from ninth grade through post secondary study to the workplace.
